Dear Interested Employee Organizations:

In accordance with Executive Order D 028 07, Section III B, Colorado WINS (COWINS) has filed a petition requesting that an election be conducted by the Colorado Division of Labor during which the employees in the occupational group known as the **Administrative Support and Related Services Unit** may vote as to whether or not they wish to have the COWINS be recognized as their Certified Employee Organization.

As set forth in the certification from the Governor's Designee dated April 7, 2008, there are 4,759 covered employees in the **Administrative Support and Related Services Unit** occupational group. Therefore, pursuant to Section III B of the Executive Order, the threshold for a successful show of interest for the **Administrative Support and Related Services Unit** occupational group is 1,428 covered employees, which is 30% of the total number of covered employees in that occupational group. COWINS submitted, and AAA, at the direction of the Division of Labor, verified a show of interest in support of COWINS from a sufficient number of covered employees to request a certification election.

Notice is given to all other interested employee organizations that they have fifteen days from the date of this announcement, April 8, 2008, to submit petitions of their own in order to request participation in this election. These organizations must submit to the Colorado Division of Labor, the Affirmation of Representation as Union Agent, in addition to the Petition for an Election and Referendum for Recognition as a Certified Employee Organization, plus the signed show of interest/petition from at least 1,428 covered employees in the **Administrative Support and Related Services Unit** occupational group, which is 30% of the total number of covered employees in the **Administrative Support and Related Services Unit** occupational group. These documents must be received by the Division of Labor no later than 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, April 23, 2008.
